Winter is now upon us, and help is needed to transport seniors, the disabled, and low-income residents of Holland and Sardinia to doctor and physical therapy appointments, clinics, pharmacies, grocery stores, colleges, work places, nutrition sites, banks, etc. Medical trips take priority. Trips are free, but donations are accepted.

Volunteer drivers are needed for as few as four hours, with a 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. shift preferred. A valid driver's license and a clean driving record are a must, but no special license is required to drive the Rural Transit van. Drivers will need to pick up the RT van at the Sardinia location, prior to doing any pickups.
